Overview

The video assignment will assess your ability to work with a post production style project in pro tools.

Objectives

In order to successfully complete this project you need the following. Organization and labeling will be graded so label everything clearly!

- Create a Pro Tools session.
- Import a 1 minute video and correctly match the session to the video frame rate.
- Import sound effects and place them appropriately and creatively.
- Import stock music for cues and background mood, or create your own!
- Do a rough mix within Pro Tools and record it. There should be 4 mixes in total!
- MIX 1 : Full Mix: including everything
- MIX 2: Music Mix: only includes musical elements
- MIX 3: Dialogue Mix: only includes dialogue elements (if any, dialogue is not required and will be considered bonus material!)
- MIX 4: Sound FX Mix: includes only sound FX ie footsteps, explosions and other types of Foley.
- Save the session as a new copy including all audio files and ensure that everything is delivered. **LINKING ERRORS ARE AN INSTANT FAIL!** So be careful when delivering files.
- ZIP the final session labeling it

Evaluation

Breakdown of grading:

- 10% - Create A Pro Tools Session
- 10% - Import Video & Session Frame Rate Lock
- 15% - Place Sound FX
- 15% - Place (Create) Music
- 10% - Full Mix
- 10% - Routing with busses/sends as well as the creation of a Mix Bus
- 10% - **4 MIXES** printed separately on their own audio tracks within Pro Tools.
- 10% - Save Session Copy zipped and named properly
- 10% - Delivered online via WeTransfer or Dropbox
- Bonus points available for creative use of effects, panning, automation, labeling, recording your own dialogue or surprising me.

Materials

- 1-minute video file either a movie preview or a clip from a movie, television show or commercial.
